Natural gas is run to the end of the street. It is not run to the house here, but it is available, would have to contact the gas company to have lines run from street. However, there is a 150 gal propane tank here, 50% full.

I know garbage pickup is available, but we don't use it. The county convenience center is very close, easier to just take it ourselves.

NOTE: we have Spectrum cable internet here. I am currently getting 451 mbps using ethernet cable and 82 mbps with wifi. The original Spectrum router gave us better wifi numbers, but this is the one Spectrum replaced it with, so 82 mbps wifi. It's still great. The only other option is AT&T, but theirs isn't even 10 mbps
